As most of you know (for some it has been a long time since we have touched base, sorry about that.) Jason and I have been living in Zambia for the past 6 years as missionaries. We moved here Feb 2013 with our then one year old daughter Marisa. Marisa is now just about 7 and our youngest daughter, Arya, is almost 3 years old. We live at Namwianga Mission and help Jason's mom, Kathi Merritt, run The Haven Child Care homes in Kalomo. The Haven is made up of 5 homes for children/young adults, 3 homes for infants and toddlers, one called Alice's House for teen girls/young ladies, and one home Called Eric's House for boys and young men. We live at Eric's house. Below is a picture of most of our kids at Alice's and Eric's House plus family.

J and I are responsible for 7 girls and 32 boys/young men. We don't have all of them in-house at one time, some are in primary or high school during the day, some are away at boarding school, some are at college or university, and some are in transition to independent living! We try to see them through higher education to help them become independent contributors of society.

We plan on being here in Zambia as long as we are needed at the Haven. Please join us on our continued journey.
